What do you say? Or should you say anything? Or you go to the annual gift of friends eagerly anticipating unwrapping the set of crystal wine glasses you've hinted at in the last few months, only to be disappointed by seeing a set of steak knives... and you're vegetarian. Should you remind your friends that you don't have a need for knives? Or is it better to sit there, smile, and pretend you're happy? It's a dilemma at best. But it's up to you to turn things around and remember that this is not a reflection of anything other than the fact that someone made an error in judgment. We were all there. And it's not always easy to do the right thing. You certainly don't want to hurt a person's feelings thinking enough about you to give you gifts. And you want to avoid having an awkward moment when you feel as if you have to say something, but you're not sure what to say. Being surprised by a bad gift can be extremely disappointing. But remember that a gift exchange is more about being with friends and enjoying time together than about the gift itself. After someone gives you a gift, you should always thank the person, even if the item is something you don't want, need, or like. It's not easy, but it shows good manners. It also shows respect for your relationship with others. After all, you don't want one of these issues to create a wedge between you and the giver. You may be tempted to regift the item, which is good, but before you decide to do it, think about whether or not the giver will expect to see it when that person goes to your home. If that's the case, hold it and pull it out just before the visit. After a year or two, you can put the item away for good or donate it to a worthwhile charity. If the gift is a wearable item, wear it once when you will meet the person and then store it for later donations. It's always a good idea to keep it for a year, though, because gift giver might ask about it, and you don't want to have to lie. Never be rude and say or do something that might hurt someone's feelings or shame her. You don't want to be backpedal and spend the rest of the time apologizing for something you say. After you thank the friend for her thoughtfulness, change the subject and hope that she doesn't ask what you like best about the item. No matter what gift you receive, you should always write a thank you note to the person who thinks enough of you to give you the gift. When writing thank you note, mention the gift at least once, but insist on some other aspects of the occasion. That at least acknowledges that you appreciate the thoughts behind the gift, but more importantly, it shows that you appreciate the relationship with that person.
